Runnymede Pleasure Grounds

Design Feasibility Study

CBA during 2013 assisted the Magna Carta Stakeholder Partnership in creating a Landscape Masterplan for Runnymede and Ankerwyke. Runnymede Pleasure Grounds was included within the Masterplan as part of the overall studied landscape, although as quite a separate entity both in character and use. The Pleasure Grounds function as an urban park space but within the unique setting of the semi-rural river landscape at Runnymede. It's riverside setting and attractive landscape help to draw visitors from a very wide area, not just locally, but from urban areas at some distance from the site. Although a popular space the Pleasure Grounds struggle at times to cope with visitor numbers particularly in the range of recreational activities. Following on from the Masterplan study, CBA were appointed by Runnymede Borough Council Open Spaces in April 2014 to develop a Vision for Runnymede Pleasure Gardens based around initial concept designs for the Grounds.
