CBA is working with Hurtwood Park to bring a new concept to the UK - a Polo and Equestrian Estate. This will include 4 polo fields, a boutique hotel, spa, equestrian arena and 12 country homes for individuals with a passion for horses. The site, an existing Polo Club set within a sensitive and attractive landscape to the South of the Surrey Hills, will be carefully integrated into the landscape. The proposed landscape masterplan is consistent with the landscape character, visual amenity and landscape features of the area and has evolved from an understanding of the history, present day use and character of the landscape as well as the various landscape elements/ experiences on the site including ecology, land use, vegetation, circulation and the existing built framework. A careful landscape strategy was developed which provides a robust framework for the proposed development, enhancing existing landscape features and introducing a new landscape structure of woodland tree planting, hedgerow, meadow and buffer planting. The masterplan provides a setting into which new buildings can be sited to create an integrated landscape which comfortably sits within the surrounding area and augments the current landscape character of the site.
