Leading a multidisciplinary team, CBA designed and completed the regeneration and restoration of this historic park and palace on the Thames riverside. The park is now a key London visitor 'destination' as well as a much loved local open space. CBA's proposals resulted in a fresh and contemporary look for the park including the now restored and popular 'Fulham Beach' and water features, and a new central hub of facilities for park users. Extensive consultation was a critical part of the design process and engendered the continual support of the community. A constant theme in this was the balancing of conservation of historic features with contemporary leisure provision. Funded in part by the Heritage Lottery Fund the project also incorporated the restoration of the adjacent Grade II listed Fulham Palace. The latter includes building conservation, a new education suite and organic food production in the Walled Garden.
