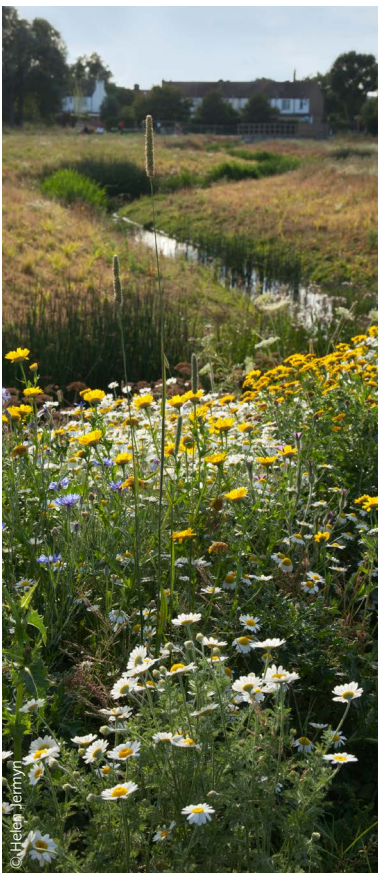

Lordship Recreation Ground, Tottenham lies adjacent to the Broad Water Farm estate. The masterplan for the park's restoration was developed in conjunction with the Friends of Lordship Park and wider public and stakeholder consultation. The project was successfully implemented in 2013. Key features of the scheme include the restoration of the River Moselle, which previously flowed in a culvert through the park, restoration of a 1930's model traffic area which is utilised and managed by a cycling charity, a new ecology/education centre, a city farm and new play areas, in addition to general hard and soft landscape improvements.

In 2013, the project received a gold prize at the London Bloom Awards in recognition of the increase in biodiversity, the dedicated involvement of the friends group and the project's contribution to improving the quality of life for the local community. It was among seven green spaces to be recognised by London's top environmental award.
