Stonehenge Visitor Centre, Wiltshire

The visitor experience at Stonehenge has long needed improvement. CBA's work here began with the preparation of a Management Plan for the 2000ha World Heritage Site which has at its focus the Stonehenge monument. More recently CBA was successful in securing planning permission for the creation of a new state-of-the-art visitor centre to this world famous visitor destination. The project includes for the development of a new access strategy for visitors and environmental enhancements to improve the quality of the landscape experience. CBA is part of the multidisciplinary team who have masterplanned, designed and delivered the new visitor centre. The 'landscape building' sits lightly in the landscape and the related infrastructure is successfully absorbed into the folds of the chalkland without impact on archaeology. The project is due for completion in 2014.
