As part of a strategy to reduce its carbon emissions, the trustees of Glyndebourne Opera House took the decision to commission and install a wind turbine within the Glyndebourne estate in the South Downs National Park in East Sussex. CBA was commissioned to advise on the landscape and visual impacts of the wind turbine scheme, which secured consent following a Public Inquiry. CBA prepared the landscape and visual impact assessment for the Environmental Statement submitted in support of the planning application, and acted as the expert landscape witness for the client at the Public Inquiry (alongside Sir David Attenborough). The wind turbine was approved by the Secretary of State in 2011, and has become an iconic landmark for visitors to Glyndebourne and the National Park.
