Durham City Vision is delivering the physical regeneration of the city. Objectives reflect the need to enhance the city centre's economic status without compromising its cultural heritage. Renewal projects are being promoted that reinforce the city as a market town service sector, foster Durham's knowledge economy, position it as a hub for public sector employment and enhance the city as a visitor destination. The redevelopment of a series of riverside sites to the north of the city is a high priority and includes the Freeman's Place redevelopment site. CBA is part of a developer-led team delivering this project. Close to the heart of Durham's World Heritage Site the 1ha Freeman's Place site comprises a mixed use development with gateway and riverside public realm spaces. The latter unlock the potential of the riverside, connect to the city's wider public realm spaces and extend 'the experience' of Durham. CBA is designing and delivering those spaces.
